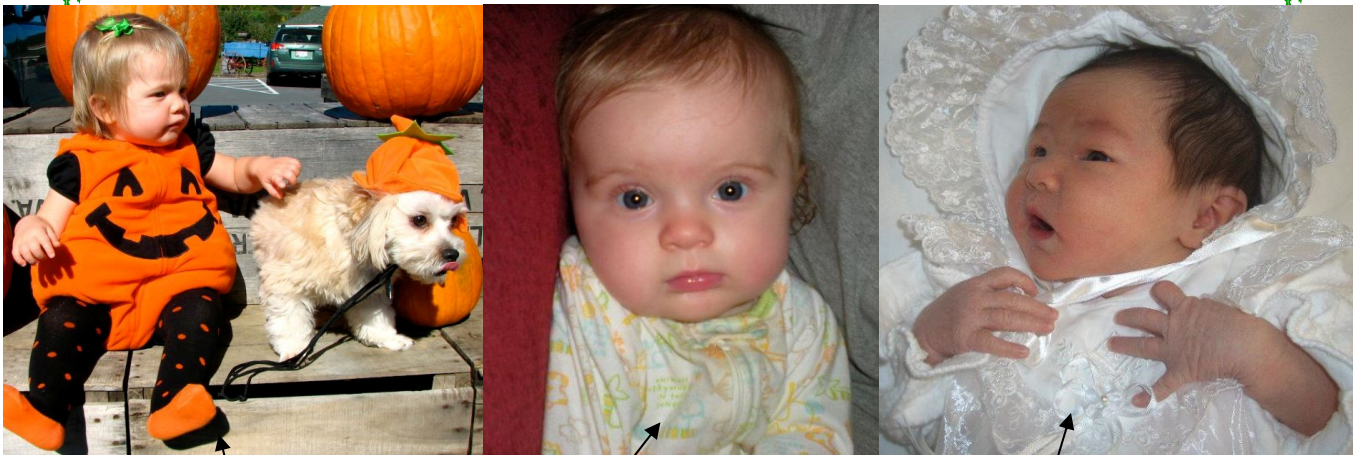


## 2011 Govier Family Update
